## Phones on camp

In consultation with staff, leaders and parents, we have thought hard about how to best approach the use of phones on camp.

- Junior High (Years 6-8) will not be taking phones on camp. Parents will be able to contact directors if they need to make contact with their youth.
- Senior High (Years 9-12) will be able to use phones minimally for brief contact home or taking photos. Phone usage outside of these purposes or reasonable hours will lead to phones being checked in securely with camp directors until the end of camp.
- Leaders will be able to use phones minimally for taking photos or brief communication with the team.

We will be having a welcoming and orientation session before loading the buses and departing. Camp commences at 12 noon.
